

FAQs

Here is a list of Frequently Asked Questions – please have a look through here. If you can't find an answer to your query, please <u>contact us</u>.

Q: How long can you hold a date for us?

A: We are happy to hold a date without deposit for 7 days

Q: What time is music allowed until?

A:Our entertainment license runs until Midnight on Saturdays, and until 11pm from Sunday to Thursday

Q: What time does the bar close?

A: 15-20 minutes before the end of the party

Q: Can we bring our own drinks?

A: You can supply your own wine, sparkling wine and champagne – we will charge corkage on this PER 75CL

Q: how do we work out the cost of our wedding?

A: It's the venue hire (appropriate to the time of year and day of the week), plus any food and drink options, plus any additional accommodation or camping facilities. You can charge your guests if you wish.

Q: Do you have outside caterers?

A: No. All our catering is done in house with the exception of the wedding cake

Q: How do we choose our food options?

A: Please see our **MENUS** link on the Wedding page of our website. We can also prepare a bespoke menu for you if this is something you require. This is usually more expensive.

Q: Can we book in for a food tasting prior to the wedding?

A: You can. The cost is £110.00 per person

Q: Can we have a live band or a DJ?

A: Yes. Both if you like. All amplified music takes place in the Dining Hall. Any paid performers must have (by law) public liability insurance and all electrical equipment over 12 months old must be covered by a valid PAT certificate

Q: Can we have a band in the marquee?

A: The marquee is not licensed for live music, but you can have background music all evening, or acoustic performers until 21:00

Q: Do you have a ceremony license

A: Yes we do – the whole farm is licensed, including the gardens, fields, the stone circle at the top of the hill and the surrounding fields.

There are two indoor rooms I to choose from: the Garden Room which seats a maximum of 80 people with more standing and the Dining Hall which seats a maximum of 50 people.

Q: Can we have confetti?

A: Natural petals only – fresh or dried. No rice paper, foil or 'natural'/'biodegradable' confetti

Q: Do you supply breakfast?

A: Breakfast is included for your guests who are booked into bedrooms on the morning after the wedding (or both mornings if you are staying for 2 nights).

Guests from other B&B's or hotels may also join you, as may campers and glampers – there will be an additional charge for this.

Q: Can we have a ceilidh band, or 'barn' dance?

A: You can. This would need to be in our dining marquee and started by 7pm (due to the nature of our music license this would need to be finished by 9pm, thus the 7pm start) The timing of this will dictate the timings of all other events throughout the day leading to this point).

Q: Can we have candles?

A: No naked flames – only candles completely covered by lanterns, or tealights in jam jars (a little sand in the bottom prevents the bottoms of the jar burning the tables)

Q: Where do people park?

A: There is a guest car park adjacent to the farmhouse garden with parking for over 100 cars; B&B guests can park on the driveway and outside some of the accommodation. There are also 2 hardstanding yards: 1 at the bottom of the driveway and 1 at the top.

Q: Can we feed the animals during our stay?

A: We feed the animals every morning meeting at around 8:30 at the little house on mushrooms stilts.

Q: Can you cater for special diets?

A: Yes, with a little notice we can usually do anything

Q: Do you have travel cots and high chairs?

A: Yes, we have 6 high chairs.

We supply travel cots free of charge in Blue Room, Panelled Room, Studio, Cider House & Apple Loft – we do not supply linen for these

Q: Do you have Garden Games?

A: We do have some garden games and you are welcome to use these free of charge. They include Giant Jenga, Giant 4 in a Row, a Coconut Shy (please supply coconuts!) – we also may have other games, please ask.

Q: Can we have a bonfire?

A: Yes. We can supply a bonfire – we charge for this. John is a keen bonfire builder and makes them big!

Q: If we choose a non-legal ceremony, such as a 'hand-fasting', can we choose our own celebrant

A: Yes. We have some recommendations too!

Q: Do you have camping pitches?

A: Yes. Camping pitches are subject to weather and will per charged per pitch per night. There is a shower block with hot showers, and mains toilets and mains water in the field. There is also a heated shower block with hot showers and flushing loos next to the café. Campers can book in for breakfast if required at an additional cost.
